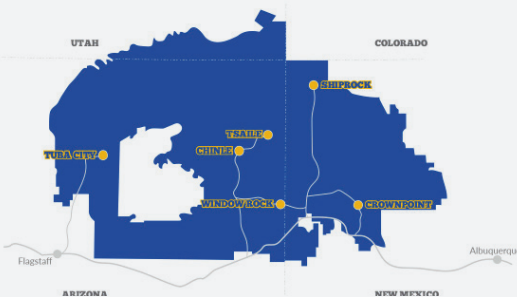
Our mission is to advance quality post-secondary student learning and development to the well-being of the Diné pteople.



## ABOUT DINÉ COLLEGE

Diné College was founded in 1968 as the first tribal college (TCU) in the United States. Diné College is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission (hlcommission.org), a regional accreditation agency recognized by the U.S. Department of Education. Located in Arizona and New Mexico on the Navajo Nation, Diné College predominately serves Navajo students (92%). The college is a four-year institution and offers 11 bachelor's degrees, 19 associate's degrees and 8 certificates. The main campus in Tsaile has student dormitories and a cafeteria. The school participates in athletic competitions in rodeo, archery and cross-country. The school is governed by a eight-member Board of Regents.

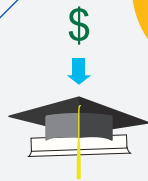
